

Filing for City of Live Oak Election for May 1, 2021, beginning January, 2021

The City of Live Oak will be holding its General Election on May 1, 2021 for the purpose of electing Council Members in Place 1, Place 3 and Place 5 for a two-year term, from May 2021 to May 2023.

Any candidate desiring to have his or her name on the Official Ballot shall, no sooner than Wednesday, January 13, 2021 through Friday, February 12, 2021, 5:00 p.m., file with the City Secretary an application in writing in the form prescribed by the Texas Election Code requesting that his or her name be placed on the Official Ballot and declaring themselves as a candidate.

All candidates for office in the City of Live Oak must, at the time of filing for office, attained the age of 21, be a qualified voter and have been a resident of the city for at least twelve (12) consecutive months.
