**Health & Wellness Tips**

**How Inflammation Can Hurt You**

What do splinters, and tooth extractions all have in common? Inflammatory response plays an important role in your immune system. They both trigger the inflammatory response in your body.

Think of the inflammatory response as first responders on the scene of an accident. Pain, heat, redness, swelling, and loss of function are going to show up to isolate and clean up the injured area. They jump-start the healing process and keep you safe from the infection spreading.

This type of inflammation is referred to as acute inflammation. As soon as you remove the splinter, or your body heals from the tooth removal, these first responders pack up and go home.

Problems arise when your inflammatory response chooses to stick around. This is referred to as chronic inflammation. Left untreated, it can damage your organs, destroy bone and tissue, alter the DNA inside your cells, and increase your risk of cancer.

Chronic inflammation is harmful over a long period of time. When left unchecked, it can lead to long term diseases including heart disease, diabetes, dementia, irritable bowel syndrome, rheumatoid arthritis, and periodontal disease (commonly called gum disease).

# FOUR SIGNS THAT IT'S A SCAM



- Scammers **PRETEND** to be from an organization you know.  
Scammers often pretend to be from a business you know like a utility company, a tech company, or even the police department.  
They use technology to change the phone number that appears on your caller ID. So the name and number you see might not be real.
- Scammers **PRESSURE** you to act immediately.  
Scammers want you to act before you have time to think. If you're on the phone, they might tell you not to hang up so you can't check their story.  
They might threaten to arrest you, sue you, take away your drivers or business license or deport you. They might say your computer is about to be corrupted.
- Scammers say there's a **PROBLEM** or a **PRIZE**.  
They might say you're in trouble with the government or you owe money. Or someone in your family had an emergency. Or that there's a virus on your computer.  
Some scammers say there's a problem with one of your accounts and that you need to verify some information.
- Scammers tell you to **PAY** in a specific way.  
They often insist that you pay by using cryptocurrency, by wiring money through a company like MoneyGram or Western Union or by putting money on a gift card and then giving them the number on the back.  
Some will send you a check (that will later turn out to be fake), then tell you to deposit it and send them the money.

## HOW TO AVOID A SCAM

Know how scammers tell you to pay. Never pay someone who insists you pay with cryptocurrency, a wire transfer service like Western Union or MoneyGram or a gift card. And NEVER deposit a check and send money back to someone.

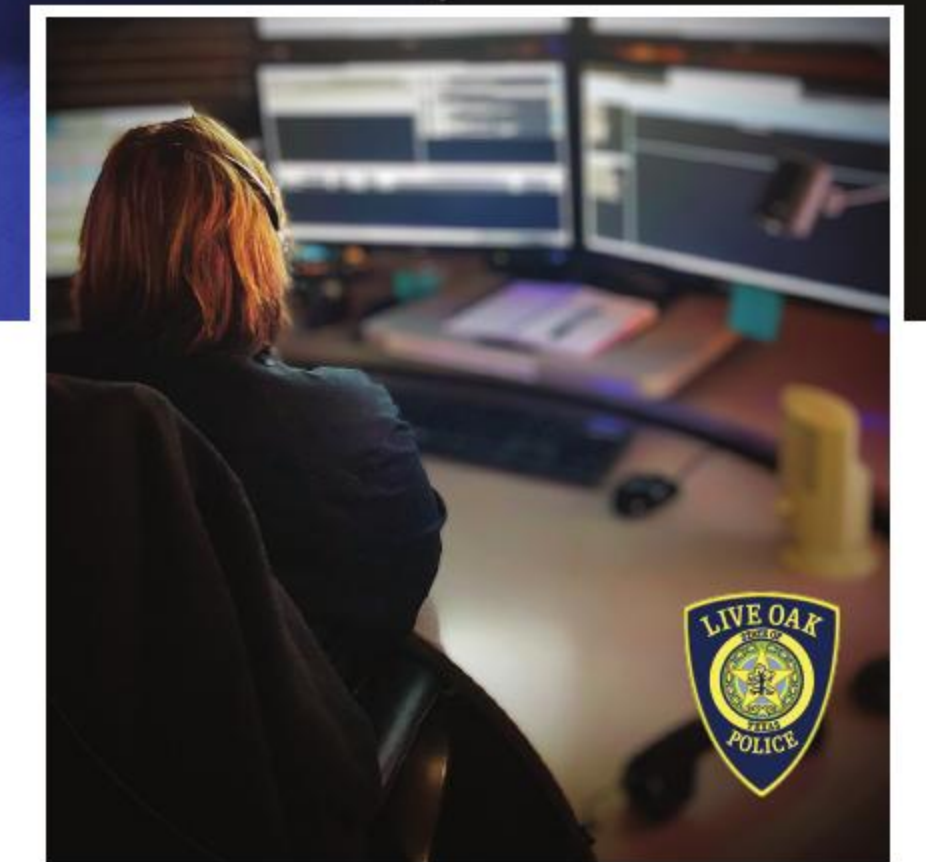
## Unsung Heroes Saving a Life One Call at a Time

Most people are familiar with the thin blue line representing law enforcement. But, did you know about the thin yellow line? The thin yellow line represents the unsung heroes of every public safety agency, the telecommunicators. The men and women who work in the City of Live Oak Telecommunications division are the first persons you speak with when you dial 911 or to the non-emergency number for the city of Live Oak.

They manage incoming calls and transfers and respond to both emergency and non-emergency calls for fire, law enforcement, and emergency medical services for multiple agencies. In addition, the telecommunicators also dispatch the city's animal control, utilities, and streets department. They must be able to remain calm under pressure, using excellent communication skills, and make quick decisions to ensure the safety of both first responders and the public.

Our telecommunicators complete a rigorous training program, which includes completing several state-mandated courses. They must complete and pass a state examination and are licensed by TCOLE (Texas Commission on Law Enforcement). Emergency telecommunicators are the vital link between a person in distress or a critical incident and the help needed to mitigate the situation.

Telecommunicators in the State of Texas have been recognized



as first responders since June of 2019. During the second week of April of each year, telecommunicators are recognized across the nation for their commitment, service, and sacrifice.

In 2022 Live Oak telecommunicators processed over 54,000 calls. Telecommunicators are rarely seen, but always heard. They are able to multitask in a very stressful environment and are the calming voices on the other end of the phone. They are trained to accurately listen and disseminate the information when the caller may not be at their best.

Telecommunicators will always be ready to serve our citizens at the highest level of professionalism. They do this because they want to make a difference. Because of their training, professionalism, and dedication, our telecommunicators are just one reason why the City of Live Oak is the premier community to live, learn, work and play.

## Northeast Lakeview College and Bezos Academy Bring Tuition-Free Preschool to Campus

Northeast Lakeview College to be a host site for Bezos Academy preschool, expected to begin welcoming students in 2024.

"Bezos Academy is thrilled to partner with Northeast Lakeview College to bring tuition-free preschool to San Antonio," said Mike George, President of Bezos Academy. "For too many kids and their families, preschool isn't an option due to cost or because there simply isn't enough availability. We're excited to have the opportunity to serve the students, staff, and surrounding community members." The school is slated to open in late 2024, following renovations that Bezos Academy will make to the building.

Families earning up to 400% of the federal poverty level with children aged 3-4 are eligible to apply. That includes families of four earning up to \$120,000/year. Bezos Academy provides admissions preference to children experiencing homelessness or in foster care. 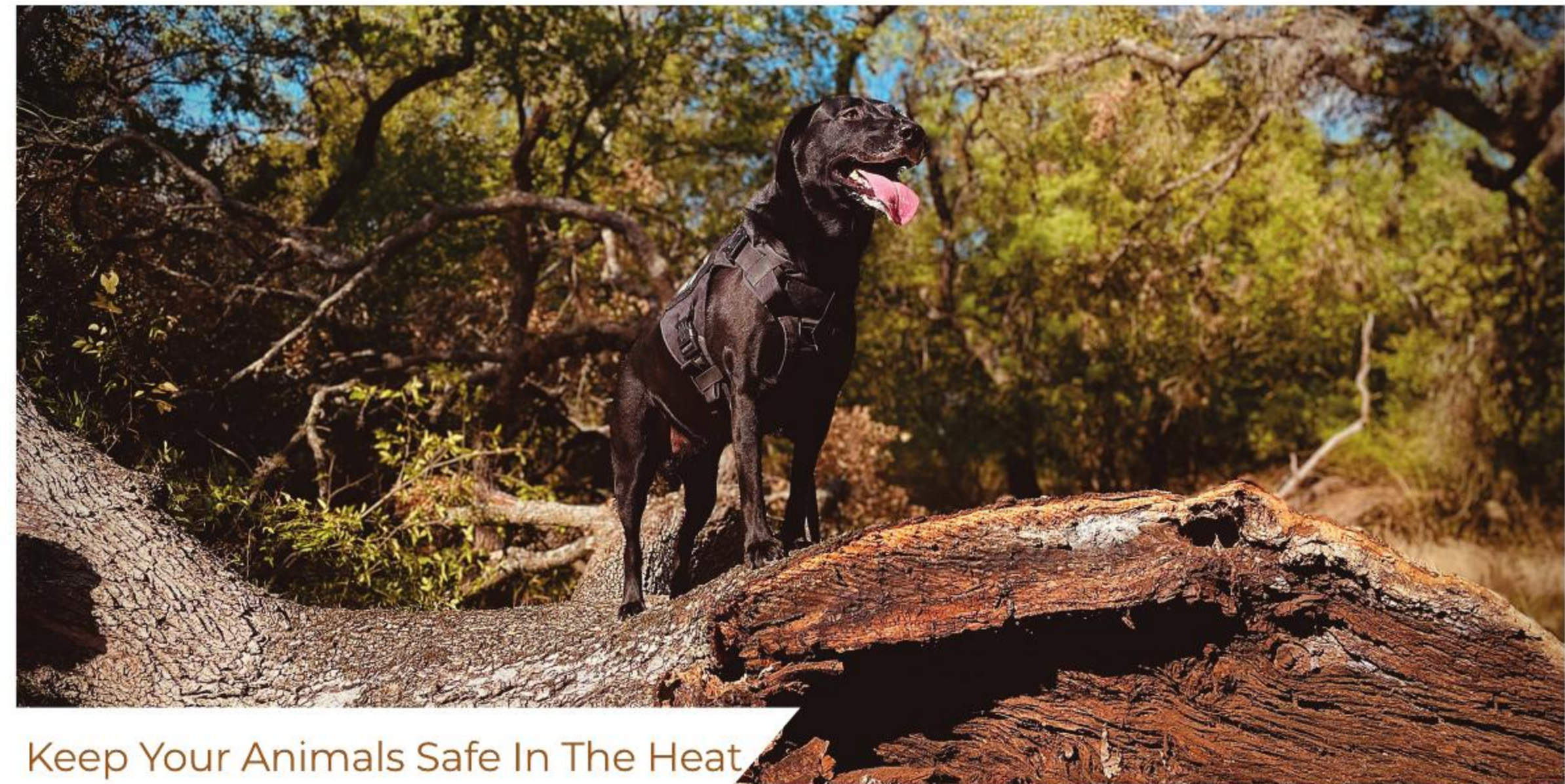

- Walk your pets during the early morning hours or the late evening hours to avoid hot asphalt temperatures. Paw damage can happen in 60 seconds. The City parks are ideal for shady walks on one of the trail paths.
- Know the symptoms of overheating in pets, which include excessive panting or difficulty breathing, increased heart and respiratory rate, drooling, mild weakness, stupor or even collapse. Symptoms can also include seizures, bloody diarrhea and vomit along with an elevated body temperature of over 104 degrees.
- Never leave your animals in a parked vehicle.
- Pets can dehydrate quickly, so give them plenty of fresh, clean water and make sure they have a shady place to get out of the sun. Always have water with you during walks for you and your pet.

Seven out of every 10 adults in the U.S. have a grill or a smoker, which creates an increased risk of home fires. On average, fire departments have gone to approximately 8,900 home fires involving grills. With the rise in popularity of grilling in the upcoming months, here are some quick safety tips that can help you and the family avoid potential fire hazards.

**Safety Tips**

- Propane and Charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- The grill should be placed well away from home and deck railing and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Check your grill for leaks.
- Keep barbecue pits and charcoal or propane grill at least 10 feet away from your home.
- Keep children and pets at least 3 feet away from the grill.
- Never leave your barbecue grill unattended while in use.
- Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before lighting it.

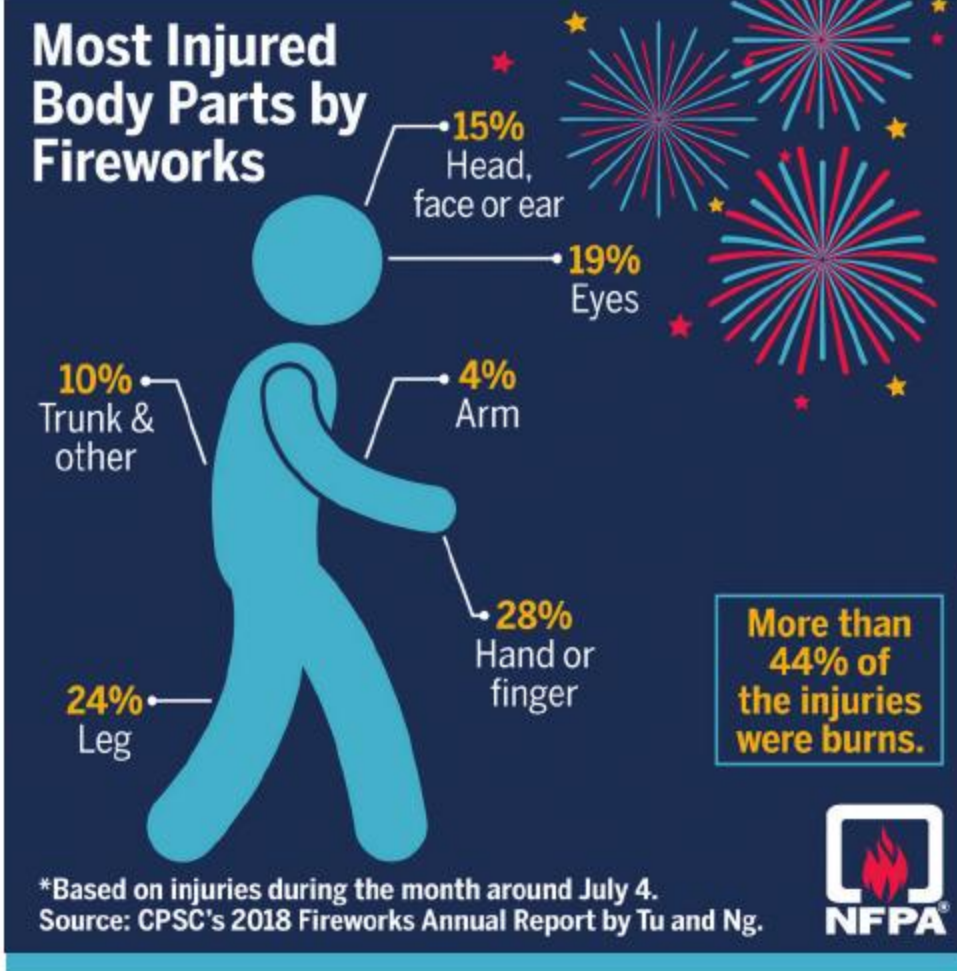

Each year, fireworks injure thousands of folks and cause thousands of fires. The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission reported that 1,500 people were treated in Emergency Rooms for fireworks injuries in 2021 and 1,100 of these injuries were from sparklers. Sparklers burn at a temperature of about 2,000 degrees Fahrenheit-hot enough to melt some metals.

**Leave the fireworks to the professionals and visit a safe professional fire work show.**

**Chapter 8. Article III. Sec 8-43 Prohibited.**  
It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, assemble, store, transport, receive, keep, sell, offer, or have in his possession with intent to sell, use, discharge, cause to be discharged, ignite, detonate, fire or otherwise set in action any fireworks of any description.

## IT'S GETTING HOT OUTSIDE

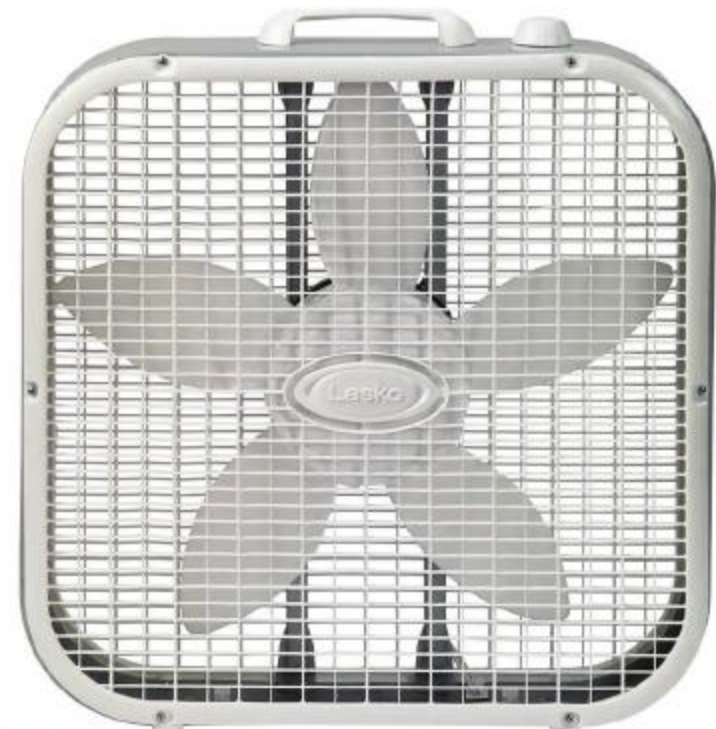

One way you can beautify your home is to plant trees or flowers around your house to add to the landscape and curb appeal. You don't need to go all out with an ornate display. A bed of brightly colored flowers or native bushes can really enhance the natural beauty of your home. Aside from looking good, plants take in carbon dioxide from the air and expel oxygen, making for a more breathable atmosphere for us all.

Keep your lawn looking good by mowing regularly. By keeping yours neat and trim, your neighborhood will shine! Be sure to keep bushes and trees trimmed to ensure they do not obstruct public walkways and paths. Maintaining your sidewalks and keeping them free of debris, old newspapers, and vehicles will help the neighborhood walkers maneuver around with ease in front of your home.

Live Oak's partnership with Waste Management (WM) offers brush and bulk pickup at your doorstep on the first Monday of each month. Your brush or bulk should be placed at the curb the night before to ensure it is included in the monthly pickup. Remember to bundle your brush into four-foot-long bundles not weighing more than 50 pounds each. WM will not pick up oversized or unbundled piles of brush. Keep bulk items and brush separate.

By following these simple rules, you are helping our neighborhood yards and streets stay clean and beautiful. As a reminder, bulky items do not include construction debris or tree limbs and tree trunks cut by a professional contractor. If you have hired a contractor, the limbs and tree trunks must be hauled off by the contractor.

Public Works and Code Enforcement are taking proactive measures to keep where you live a beautiful place. We hope you will help them by doing the same.

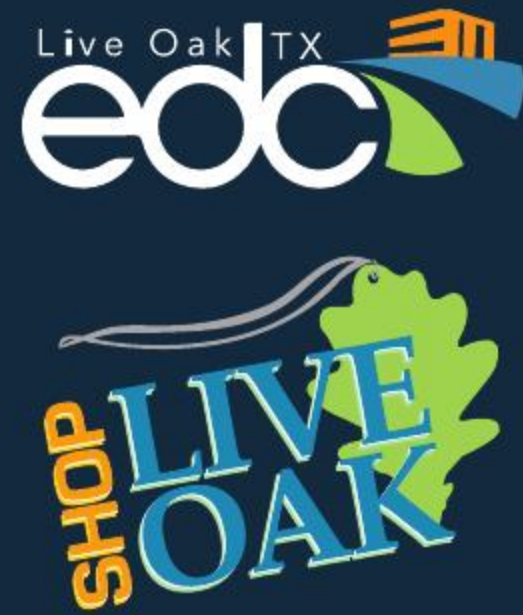
