



# May Is National Water Safety Month

National Water Safety Month is celebrated each year through educational programs in our community. This April, Recreation Coordinator Courtney Weese introduced an informative program promoting water-related safety tips to the community honoring Joshua Collingsworth.


Blake and Kathy Collingsworth created the Joshua Collingsworth Memorial Foundation after their own son Joshua passed away in a drowning incident. "Josh the Baby Otter", a book written by Blake, teaches children to always swim with a buddy and never to go around water unless they are with an adult. Josh the Baby Otter has traveled all over the country, into child care centers, preschools, kindergarten classrooms and aquatic facilities...and this April he made his way into a local elementary school here in Live Oak!

After hearing Joshua's story and meeting Blake and Kathy, Courtney felt an overwhelming need to share their foundation's mission and the story of "Josh the Baby Otter." Expanding upon the current aquatics program FISH (Families Incorporating Safe Habits), Courtney and a surprise guest visited Ed Franz Elementary School to spread the message of water safety. She read the story of Josh to the children, provided water safety tips, and distributed a copy of "Josh the Baby Otter" book to each of the students. By the end of the day, the students were able to recite the "Josh the Otter Water Safety Pledge." This life saving message for children is simple: To stay away from water unless accompanied by an adult.

In an effort to educate children and parents alike, this campaign will be incorporated into current aquatics programs here in Live Oak. Educational materials and drowning prevention resources will be visible at the pool, and integrated into our swim lessons. This, in combination with our Life Jacket Loaner Program will serve as a kick-off to National Water Safety Month and as a reminder of how we can keep our children safe around water activities.

When you park your vehicle at work, in retail or other areas, again lock your doors. If it is night time, try to find a well-lit area to park your vehicle. As stated earlier, vehicle burglaries are crimes of opportunity. Remove all valuables from your vehicle no matter where it is parked. This includes minor things such as sunglasses, radar detectors and loose change. Never leave wallets, purses, electronics or tools in visible locations. Use the trunk of your vehicle to store items that you can not carry with you. If that is not

an option, at least make sure items are covered and not visible by someone looking in your windows.

new houses being constructed and new businesses opening frequently. We welcome all of our new neighbors and hope they enjoy our little city the way we do on a daily basis. Now that the weather is starting to head toward more frequent rain and intervals of sunshine, the grass and weeds will want to make the most of the sunlight. As we all know, the grass and weeds grow quickly in South Texas so we all need to be prepared to maintain our yards to keep our city clean and attractive.

Code Compliance works hard every day to remind residents of the grass ordinance, which says grass and weeds cannot exceed 12" and must not hang over the curbs. One issue that arises frequently is grass and weed clippings being blown into the streets. The clippings create driving hazards for bicyclists and cars, as well as clog our storm drains. If you have a lawn service for your

house, please ensure that clippings are removed as part of your agreement to avoid a visit from Code Compliance.

Another issue that often arises seems to be whether a person who rents a house is responsible for the grass and weeds. The answer is YES! The person occupying the house is responsible for maintaining the house and the lawn. Nice weather ahead also brings an increase in people parking their cars on the lawn for washing and other activities. Although convenient and a way to conserve some water, it is illegal to park vehicles on the grass. All tires must be parked on cement or pavement at all

times to avoid a receiving a courtesy notice. Parking on the grass is not only damaging to the grass, but fluids leaked from vehicles can find their way into groundwater, which is precious in South Texas.

**Clothes Dryer Safety** 

Recently, a fire occurred within a natural gas fueled clothes dryer. The investigation revealed that the fire occurred when a lint deposit located within the dryer ignited. The lint deposit had built-up over time within a plastic duct at the inlet of a blower within the dryer. Doing laundry is most likely a part of your everyday routine. But did you know how important taking care of your clothes dryer is to the safety of your home? With a few simple



Have your dryer installed and serviced by a professional. Do NOT use the dryer without a lint filter.

Make sure you clean the lint filter before and after each load of laundry. Remove lint that has collected around the drum.

Rigid or flexible metal venting material should be used to sustain proper air flow and drying time.

Make sure the air exhaust vent pipe is not restricted and the outdoor vent flap will open when the dryer is operating.

Once a year, or more often if you notice that it is taking longer than normal for your clothes to dry, clean lint out of the vent pipe or have a dryer lint removal service do it for you.

Keep dryers in good working order. Gas dryers should be inspected by a qualified professional to make sure that the gas line and connection are intact and free of leaks.

Make sure the correct plug and outlet are used and the machine is connected properly. **NEVER use an extension cord to run a large household appliance.** 

Follow the manufacturer's operating instructions and don't overload your dryer.

Turn the dryer off if you leave home or when you go to bed.

If the citizen believes that there may be a fire and/or medical emergency related to the use of fireworks, he/she should dial 9-1-1 and request the LOFD.

Year-Round watering restrictions with an irrigation system or hose and sprinkler is permitted any day of the week, any time before 11 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

\* Stage 1: Irrigation or sprinkler watering 1 day per week at any time before 11 a.m. or after 7 p.m.

\* Stage 2: Irrigation or sprinkler watering 1 day per week from 7-11 a.m. or 7-11 p.m.

\* Stage 3: Irrigation or sprinkler watering only 1 day every other week.

\* Last digit of address determines your watering day: O or 1 = Monday; 2 or 3 = Tuesday; 4 or 5 = Wednesday; 6 or 7 = Thursday; 8 or 9 = Friday. No watering on weekends.






