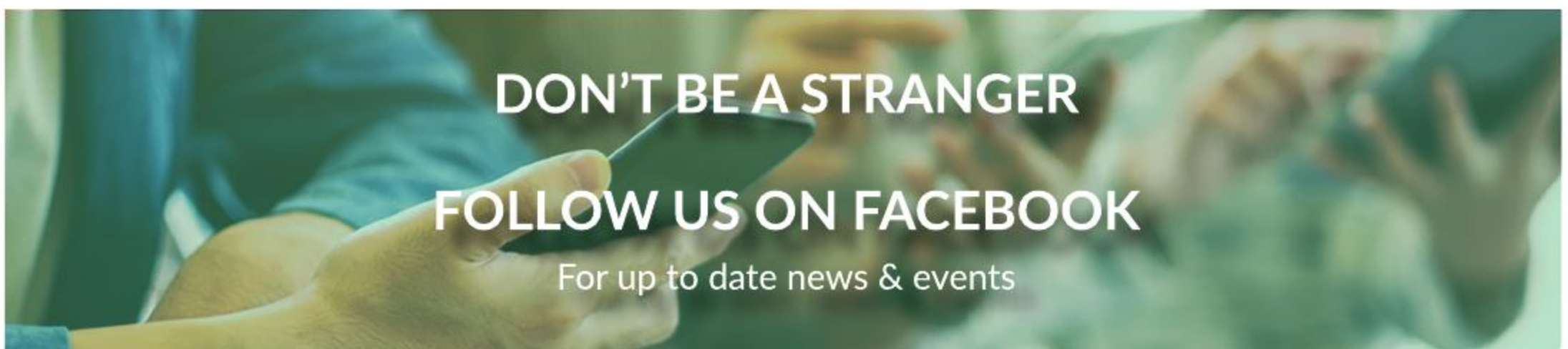

# Mayor's CORNER

Dear Residents,

In a previous Mayor's Corner, I mentioned several bills the Team was monitoring during the legislative session. Two of these bills were the \$18 billion residential property tax-cut under Senate Bill 2 and Senate Bill 3, part of the agreement that would help small businesses by cutting franchise taxes.

Senate Bill 2 will give Texans the biggest property tax cut in the State's history. The bill provides for \$12.7 billion in tax relief for property owners by (1) reducing school district property tax rates by subsidizing public education with an additional \$12 billion; (2) raising the homestead exemption from \$40,000 to \$100,000 and \$110,000 for seniors and people with disabilities; (3) limiting appraisal value increases to 20 percent per year for non-homesteaded properties under \$5 million, as part of a 3-year pilot program; and (4) exempting businesses with annual revenue of less than \$2.47 million from the franchise tax, up from a \$1.23 million exemption threshold. The bill, if passed, will not provide any direct relief to renters.



In addition, it will require counties with 75,000 or more people to have an appraisal district board of directors with up to five directors appointed by the taxing units. Three of the directors will be elected by county voters.

What does SB2 mean for schools? The bill, if approved by the voters, will require the Commissioner of Education to recalculate every district's tax rate with a 10.7 percent reduction. The rates will vary by district but will stay within 90 percent of each other. Public school districts will receive less revenue to fund operations under this law. To make up the revenue, the State of Texas will provide an additional \$12 billion to the Education Budget.

How does SB3 affect small to mid size businesses? Senate Bill 3 eliminates the State franchise tax for small to mid-size businesses. They will no longer have to pay the tax or submit a "no tax due" form. Eligible business owners will collectively save approximately \$300,000 annually.

Voters must pass both bills in a constitutional election in November to be effective in the 2023 tax year. The November ballot will ask voters whether they want the state to spend funds on property tax relief. Like most bills, there are pros and cons in every piece of legislation.

Finally, the City Council and I invite you to join us during this year's Shin Dig on Shin Oak, Saturday, September 23, from 4p-10p and Family Fun Night on Tuesday, October 31st, from 6pm-8pm. Both City events will be held in front of City Hall. Pet Pawlooza is back and will be held on Saturday, October 7th from 9am-4pm at the Clubhouse. Remember, the best is yet to come for the premier community to live, learn, work, and play.

# FEMA

## Notice to Residents Regarding the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA)

SFHA is the area subject to inundation by a 100-year flood, as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) compiled by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This notice is designed to make you more aware of local flood hazards, the need to keep flood insurance in force, and other topics related to flood preparedness. Please take a few minutes to review all of the items presented and determine what actions you may need to take in order to protect yourself.

Flooding in Live Oak can come with little warning. The flood in October of 1998 covered streets within 30 minutes of forming. Even though water over the streets appears to move slowly (three feet per second), a flood six inches deep can knock a man off his feet and less than a foot can sweep away a car.

Your property may be high enough that it was not flooded recently. However, it can still be flooded in the future because the next flood could be worse. This notice gives you some ideas of what you can do to protect yourself.

### What You Can Do Ahead of Time:

- Rake up and bag leaves as often as possible before storms. Leaves clogging storm drains are the primary source of most floods. Do not dump or throw anything into drainage ditches or streams. Blocked drainage ways simply cannot carry water. When it rains, the water has to go somewhere. Every piece of litter contributes to flooding.
- Check with Live Oak’s Development Services Department (210-653-9140, ext. 2244) before you build on, alter, regrade, or fill on your property. Permit(s) may be required to ensure that projects do not cause problems on other properties.
- Homeowner's insurance policies do not cover damage from floods. Get at least three quotes on flood insurance. If you do not have flood insurance, talk to your insurance agent.

### During A Flood-Safety Tips:

- Do not walk through flowing water. Drowning is the number one cause of flood deaths, mostly during flash floods. Currents can be deceptive; six inches of moving water can knock you off your feet. If you walk in standing water, use a pole or stick to ensure the ground is still there.
- Do not drive through a flooded area. More people drown in their cars than anywhere else. Don't drive around road barriers because the road or bridge may be washed out.
- Stay away from power lines and electrical wires. The number two flood killer after drowning is electrocution. Electrical current can travel through water. Report downed power lines to City Public Service (CPS) or Live Oak’s emergency management office/ Fire Department.
- If your house is flooded, have your electricity turned off by CPS. Some appliances, such as television sets, keep electrical charges even after they have been unplugged.

**Year-Round Watering** - These are in effect when we ARE NOT under any specific drought restrictions.

**Stage 1** - restrictions begin when the 10-day rolling average of the Edwards Aquifer level DROPS to 660 feet

**Stage 2** - restrictions begin when the 10-day rolling average of the Edwards Aquifer level REACHES 650 feet

**Stage 3** - restrictions MAY begin when the 10-day rolling average of the Edwards Aquifer level drops to 640 feet

**Stage 4** - restrictions may be declared if the total supply of water from the Edwards Aquifer and other sources is insufficient to meet customer demand. **KNOW YOUR STAGE AND DO YOUR PART**

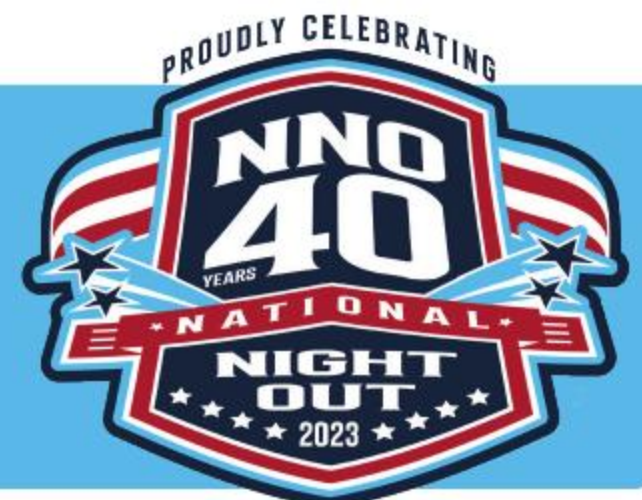

## TRAINING TOWER RECEIVES UPDATES

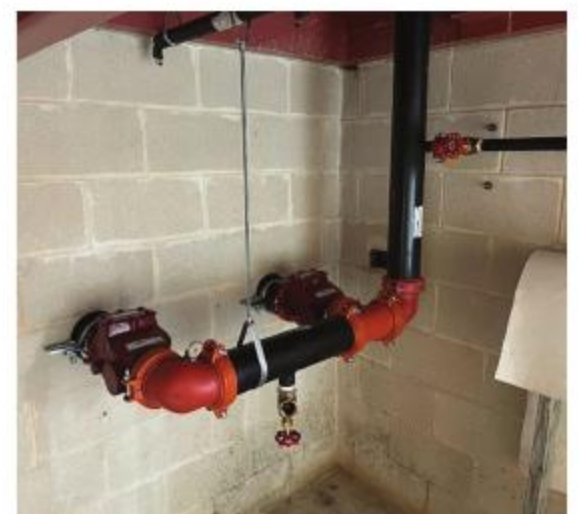
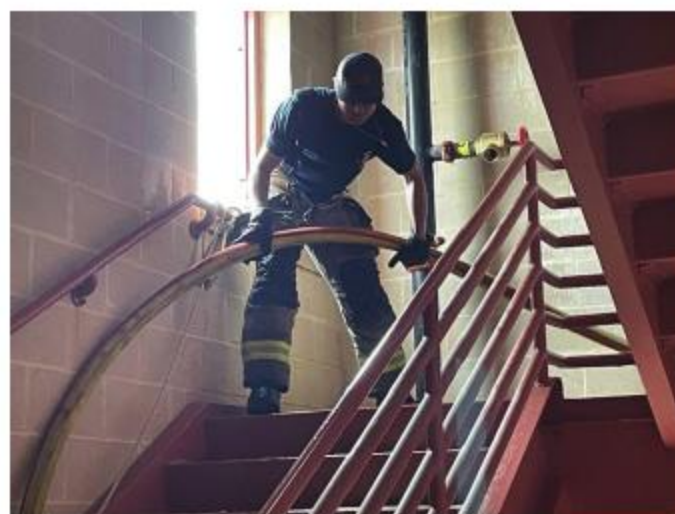
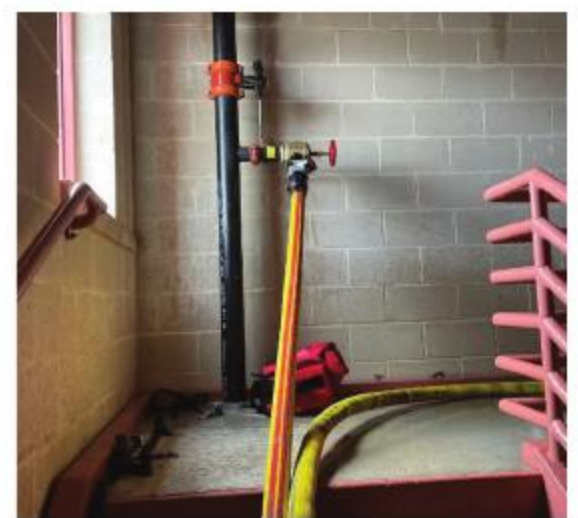
The Live Oak Fire Department would like to give a big THANK YOU to Allegiance Fire Protection for installing a standpipe/sprinkler training prop within the fire department's training tower. The standpipe/sprinkler training prop is a fully functioning standpipe system that can be used as a training for the deployment of hose line and connection of supply hose to the single inlet fire department connection. This specialized training device is a cost-effective way for fire departments to conduct Engine Company training and will provide critical training firefighters need when working in buildings during a real-life emergency. The new system can demonstrate fire sprinkler activation as well.

What is a standpipe system? A standpipe system is defined by National Fire Protection Association 14, Standard for the Installation of Standpipe and Hose Systems, as, "An Arrangement of piping, valves hose connection and allied equipment installed in a building or structure, with the hose connections located in such a manner that water can be discharged in streams through attached hose and nozzles, for the purpose of extinguishing a fire, thereby protecting a building or structure and its contents in addition to protecting the occupants.

The standpipe system, essentially, is a way firefighters can move water from a remote location to another location within the building, without the need to drag long lengths of hose throughout the building. The Live Oak Fire Department believes that education and constant training is essential to ensure the safety of our residents, businesses, and our firefighters. We are proud to call Allegiance Fire Protection a partner.

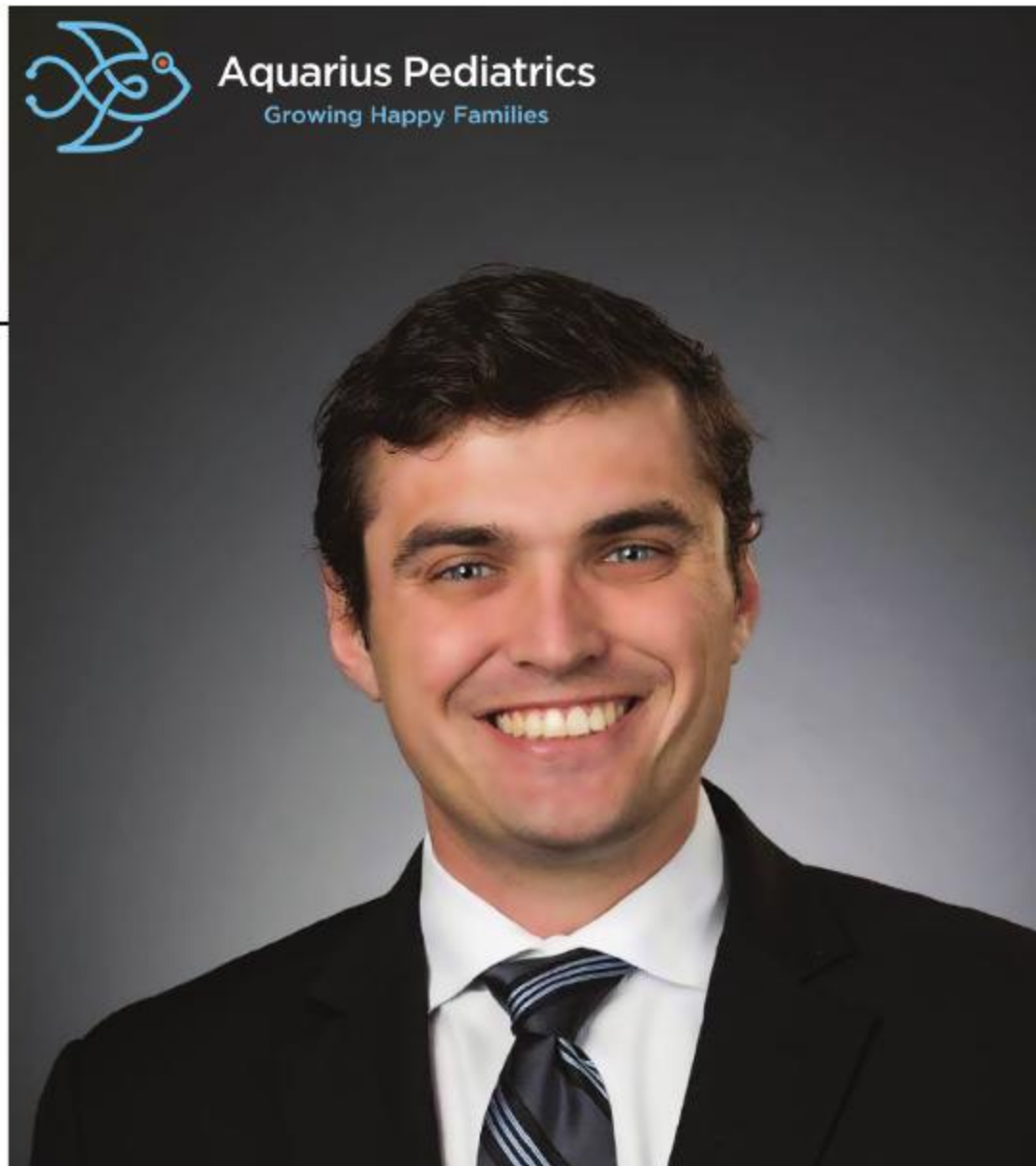

## Visual Improvement Business Testimonial

### Live Oak's Visual Improvement Program helps bring WBU-SA to life

Are you wondering who moved into the big blue and white building at the Village Oaks Shopping Center? The one with the brand-new parking lot with "WBU" stamped in yellow on all the spaces?

For those who may not be familiar, WBU stands for Wayland Baptist University, and that blue and white building is its San Antonio campus. WBU-SA was established back in 1984 and spent a few years moving around San Antonio, looking for a place to settle down. In March 2020, it moved into the building that formerly housed the Alamo Community Colleges District (ACCD) offices in Live Oak. WBU-SA is proud to call this building home!

This past June, thanks to the support of the City of Live Oak's Economic Development Corporation (EDC) and the Visual Improvement Program (VIP), the WBU-SA parking lot received a much-needed face-lift. Up until this summer, the campus parking lot was completely faded and virtually unmarked, and the campus (and its presence) seemed to get lost in the background. With the encouragement of Donna Lowder, director of the EDC, WBU-SA applied for and was awarded a \$5,000 VIP grant to be used toward the cost of seal-coating and re-stripping the campus parking lot.

The purpose of the VIP is to "promote a positive city image reflecting order, harmony, and pride, thereby strengthening the economic stability in Live Oak business areas." It focuses on the visual improvement and enhancement of facades, business signage, landscaping, and parking lots for commercial, professional, and retail structures in Live Oak. The VIP application

process is easy, and the City staff are available to provide assistance as needed. Eligible applicants can apply once per funding cycle, and funds can be used for masonry facades, awnings, entrance upgrades/doors, windows, exterior painting, xeriscape-type landscaping, signage replacement, green enhancements, and even correction of exterior code violations.

What a dramatic difference the new lot has made. It has improved the look of the campus, and it is much more noticeable now, which is important for students and business. WBU-SA is extremely grateful to the City of Oak and VIP for helping make this happen.
