WHAT'S UNIQUE ABOUT JECA?

Judson Early College Academy (JECA) is the result of an eleven-year partnership between Judson ISD and Alamo Colleges - Northeast Lakeview College (NLC). Located on the NLC campus, JECA is an early college high school designed to enable students to earn an Associates of Arts in Liberal Arts degree and, at the same time, earn a high school diploma with Distinguished Level of Achievement.

ABOUTJECA

At Judson Early College Academy, each student is someone that has potential and we work to develop them to be college and career ready from day one. Last year our seniors secured about \$33 million in scholarships to colleges and universities across the nation. Students will experience life in high school and life as a college student simultaneously. All JECA students will have the opportunity to participate in activities offered by both JECA and NLC as well as those offered at their JISD home campuses. HOW WILL YOUR CHILD BE SERVED ACADEMICALLY

- Innovative Learning: We emphasize the whole student making connections across subject areas with both digital and traditional tools. We are a one-to-one school and each student is provided with a district issued Google Chromebook.
- A Safe and Caring Environment: This is fundamental at our school. A child must feel safe to really learn during the day. With small class sizes, students are provided with not only academic support but social and emotional support.
- Associates Degree: A robust dual credit degree plan emphasis helps students earn college class credits at Northeast Lakeview College while working on their diploma at no extra expense. Students begin taking dual credit in the 9th and 10th credit and by senior year are considered full time college students by taking 12 college hours a semester.
- A rigorous high school/college experience: We feature a challenging curriculum that both inspires students and prepares students for the expectations of college courses. Books and tuition are paid for by JISD and NLC, a savings of more than \$10,000.
- Academic support that is unmatched: From day one, students are grouped with a highly qualified college prep instructor/advisor that is with them until senior year. An innovative curriculum is put into effect that provides students with academic coaching that prepares them for the college.
