A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD MAY 7, 2022, FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION REGARDING VARIOUS CITY CHARTER AMENDMENTS TO THE LIVE OAK CITY CHARTER

WHEREAS, Election Code Section 67.003 states that each local canvassing authority shall convene to conduct the local canvass at the time set by the canvassing authority's presiding officer not later than the 11th day after election day and not earlier than the third day after election day; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Live Oak created a Charter Review Commission for the purpose of reviewing the City of Live Oak Charter and appointed members to review and recommend revisions to the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Charter Review Commission presented a report, together with proposed changes to the City's Charter to the City Council and the City Council ordered a special election for such recommended revisions to the Charter; and

WHEREAS, a special election was held in the City of Live Oak, Texas, on May 7, 2022, for the purpose of proposed Charter Amendments to the Live Oak City Charter in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, said elections were duly and legally held in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of said elections have been verified and returned by the proper judges and clerks; and

WHEREAS, it appears that a total of 645 votes were cast in such elections; and

WHEREAS, the City of Live Oak hereby declares the results of such special election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIVE OAK, TEXAS:

Section 8. This Resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its final passage, and it

is so resolved.
