Job Title:

Mechanic

Brief Description:

The purpose of this position is to repair and maintain all City fleet, including heavy and small equipment. This is accomplished by diagnosing and troubleshooting equipment and vehicles, conducting preventive routine service and maintenance, performing electrical and hydraulic tests, and welding and fabricating new parts. Other duties include preserving records of services completed and parts used, and compiling information for monthly reports.

Essential Functions:

Maintains equipment and vehicles by conducting routine service inspections; running various tests on parts and systems; diagnosing problems; troubleshooting malfunctions; removing and replacing repair parts; ordering and picking-up parts; preparing equipment and parts for repair; and testing equipment to ensure proper functioning

Repairs equipment and vehicles by examining damaged equipment; removing and replacing vehicle components and parts; installing new parts as needed; welding and building new parts if warranted; taking parts and/or equipment to external vendor for repair if warranted; and test driving equipment upon completion of repair

Assists with shop duties by compiling data and records for monthly reports; keeping inventory of shop supplies and materials; ordering and picking up parts as needed; inspecting tools and equipment for potential dangers; recording services and repairs completed; answering phones; ensuring shop safety; cleaning up spills; and completing other tasks as directed

Required Experience and Training:

Work requires knowledge necessary to understand basic operational, technical, or office processes. Level of knowledge equivalent to four years of high school or equivalency. Over three years up to and including five years' experience.
