AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF LIVE OAK FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017; APPROPRIATING MONEY TO A SINKING FUND TO PAY INTEREST AND PRINCIPAL ON THE CITY'S INDEBTEDNESS; AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF LIVE OAK FOR THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR.

WHEREAS, the budget, summarized here as Exhibit A, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017 was duly presented to the City Council by the City Manager,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was ordered by the City Council, in accordance with the Texas Local Government Code, and a public notice of said hearing was caused to be given by the City Council the posting of legal notice within the Live Oak City limits, and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held according to said notice; now therefore,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIVE OAK:

SECTION 1. That the appropriations for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017, for the support of the general government of the City of Live Oak, Texas be fixed and determined for said terms in accordance with the expenditures shown in the City's Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Annual Budget, a copy of which is appended hereto as Exhibit A;

SECTION 2. That the Budget, as shown in words and figures in Exhibit A with a Summary of All Funds, is hereby approved in all respects and adopted as the City's Annual Budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017.

SECTION 3. That there is hereby appropriated the amount shown in said budget necessary to provide for a sinking fund for the payment of the principal and interest and the retirement of the bonded debt requirements of Fiscal Year 2016-2017 of the City of Live Oak.

SECTION 4. That upon adoption of this Ordinance which in all respects adopts the City of Live Oak's Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017, the Budget Book cover page, be amended to reflect all required information as outlined by Local Government Code Section 102 et. seq., including the recorded vote on the adoption of the annual budget and the property tax rates and municipal debt obligations.
