60th Diamond Anniversary Celebration

Dear Residents,

In the New Year, as we look back at the birth of the city and where it's headed, we realize how much the Live Oak community has to be thankful for. In 2020, Live Oak will celebrate its 60 years of growth, successes and prosperity for the future. Live Oak was incorporated in April 1960, giving the 316 residents a voice and the ability to make decisions about what happens in their city. The primary benefit of formally incorporating was to include a local government body, zoning regulations and to provide local fire and police services. Our rich history is just one of the many things that makes Live Oak such a unique and special place. Incorporation became official by the canvassing of the 33 votes that were cast along with the swearing in of the first Live Oak City Council which included Claude Ferrell, Elton Friesenhahn, Wilbur Friesenhahn, W.H. Brantley, Mathew Friesenhahn, Melvin Mayor, Richard Keller and Clarence Albrecht as the City's first mayor. Their first order of business in March of 1960 would be to outline the boundaries of the city, as surveyed by Robert Moffett and soon after, the City Council would conduct its first official meeting in November 1960.


Fast-forwarding to today, the City has transformed into the bustling economic retail hub of the northeast region, providing jobs, education systems and an environment for enterprise to flourish, while providing safe and beautiful neighborhoods for families to call Live Oak "their town" to raise generations of children.

As a token to commemorate the 60th Diamond anniversary, the City Council approved the purchase of challenge coins displaying the city logo as well as a special 60th anniversary logo with the Live Oak tree in a raised silhouette. The coins will be available throughout the year until supplies last. If you see a council member, stop and ask them for one of the collector coins. During this year's Shin Dig on Shin Oak, the City is preparing a special ceremony to further celebrate our successes and we hope you join us throughout the year as we look back and into the future in honor of this momentous occasion.

The City of Live Oak is proud to celebrate this anniversary with you. Cheers to "YOUR TOWN" and to the next 60 years! I am always available for your comments or questions at 210-792-7168, and remember the best is yet to come! Happy New Year.

Wow, what an amazing year in Parks and Recreation! The city has continued to provide the citizens of Live Oak and the surrounding communities with exceptional park amenities and special event programming. While we continue to look forward to new and exciting things, it's also satisfying to see all that has been accomplished over the past year.



February is always a special time in Parks and Recreation as we host the popular Daddy Daughter Dance. In 2019 the ladies were invited "Under the Big Top" for a most magical experience with their dads. It was all smiles as they danced the night away...when they weren't too busy enjoying treats such as the popcorn bar and ice cream cups!

Before you knew it, the holiday season was here once again. Every year children in Live Oak write






Throughout the year, you will find Dr. John performing

The hottest incentive package that the city's Economic Development Corporation can offer your business is the Visual Improvements Program or as we refer to it....VIP!

What is the VIP and how can it benefit your business?

Whether you are a large or small anchor, new or old business, we are here to say the VIP program can help you! Since 2011, the broad purpose of the Visual

Improvement Program has been to promote a positive city image reflecting order, harmony, and pride, thereby strengthening the economic stability in Live Oak business areas. The foremost purpose is to encourage the visual improvement and enhancement of facades, business signage, landscaping, and parking lots for commercial, professional, and retail in Live Oak.

If your business building exterior or signage needs a little TLC, then this program is for you! The funding available is based on a reimbursement up to a maximum of \$5,000 per business. The cumulative amount awarded by the Live Oak Economic Development Corporation (LOEDC) shall not exceed \$100,000 for each fiscal year of this program.

Are you eligible? If you are either the property owner or the business owner (tenant), you are eligible for the funding. Property owners with multiple buildings or tenants with multiple operating locations may be limited to one building or location per funding cycle. Once you submit your application and related documents to city staff describing the proposed work including three bids, the application will be presented before the EDC Board. Should the project and contractor receive approval from the Board; the EDC will pass a Resolution for payment of up to \$5,000 to the contractor of your choice. Should the project exceed \$5,000, the applicant is responsible for satisfying the remaining cost incurred on behalf of the project. The LOEDC will issue a deposit check not to exceed \$2,500 to the contractor prior to project commencement. Once the project is completed and has passed all permitting and inspection requirements by the city's Building Official, the balance of grant monies will be paid to the contractor.

All VIP projects awarded grant monies must start construction within 90 days of being awarded funding; all projects must be completed within one year of being awarded. Work that qualifies for reimbursement includes improvements to the exterior of buildings such as painting, cleaning, tuck pointing, façade and window repair/replacement, doorways, lighting, new signage, window tinting, replacement awnings, permanent landscaping, parking lots and rear access renovations.







Legislative Update

The 86th Texas Legislature enacted what is being called the Porch Pirate Law. House Bill 37 was signed into law by Governor Abbott and went into effect September 1, 2019. This law changes the way mail theft is handled. In the past mail theft was dealt with as all other thefts, by the value of the loss. This new law changes things. Mail to include packages delivered to your door by private carriers that is stolen could now become a felony. Any person caught stealing mail or packages from less than 10 addressees will be charged with a class A misdemeanor. Anyone caught stealing from more than 10 addressees, or stealing a package containing personal identifying information or from a disabled or elderly person is facing a felony theft charge. Hopefully this will deter some would be thieves from stealing packages from your front porch. While this may deter some, don't count on this to keep your deliveries safe.

- Protect your mail and package deliveries.
- Know your mail delivery schedule and check your mailbox dailv.
- When you order online remember what the delivery method is and the expected delivery date.
- Track your packages. If available request a delivery notification.
- for you.



We also offer funding for the Live Oak community for animal medical funding assistance in special circumstances and as funds permit, on a case by case basis. The Humane Society of Live Oak also helps with socialization and animal care at the Live Oak ACC shelter on a volunteer basis (must be over 18 years of age).
