

LOPD Junior Police Academy



The Live Oak Junior Police Academy was held the week of June 18 – 22, 2018. We had 49 Junior Police Cadets this year ranging in ages from 9 – 12. We had a very successful academy and the cadets were trained in various fields of police work. Sergeant William Feldtmose created the curriculum for the academy and oversaw the week's events with help from many LOPD officers volunteering their time to teach the Junior Cadets.



The cadets started off the week by going through an obstacle course that is part of the police departments hiring process. The course is designed to simulate different obstacles and

activities that a patrol officer would encounter during a duty day. They participated in talks about respect of others and honesty. They learned just how bad bullying can be, how it affects people and what they can do to stop it.



Cadets also received hands on training in crime scene investigation and lifting latent finger prints. They had a lot of fun during the police K9 demonstrations, seeing what the police K9's can

do and how they train. They talked with members of the SWAT team and got to look at some of the gear that is used by these officers. They received instruction on how officers try to diffuse situations and talk to people to stop problems before they start.







The streets will only be serviced once with this free pick-up so don't wait to get your items out. Please be mindful

that the items you set out for pickup must be placed in an orderly fashion and not to block the city sidewalks or your U.S. Postal mail receptacle. Utility workers will need to be able to read the water meters, so please be careful not to cover them with the debris. Please also be mindful of not blocking any line of vision for traffic with your debris and avoid parking any vehicles on the street near the discarded items. Waste Management will NOT pick up items such as televisions, batteries, oil, paints or any hazardous materials. Please check Waste Management's web site for a complete list of items they will NOT pick up.

Twice a year Live Oak has Citywide Garage Sales on Friday, Saturday and/ or Sunday. The City of Live Oak does not have garage sale fees. Participating residents please email Cathi at cpiotrowski@liveoaktx.net or by calling 210-653-9140, ext. 2234 by 4:30 p.m. Wednesday, September 26th if you would like your garage sale information posted on www.liveoaktx.net and Live Oak's Facebook page. Information needed: Street address, dates, hours, and main items for sale (i.e. TV, Children's toys, dresser, etc.).

Place your large, unwanted "treasures" near the curb by Sunday evening, September 30th for Bulk Pick Up. The following list of items will not be picked up:

- No tires, household chemicals, paint, oil or batteries
- No electronics such as Televisions, Computers, Computer Monitors and similar items.
- No appliances with Freon such as refrigerators, freezers, or window units.
- No Brush (brush will only be collected during brush pick Gold Zone 1st Thursday each month and Green Zone 3rd Thursday of each month).
- No bricks, blocks, concrete or similar construction materials.

Items cannot be placed at the curb before Monday, September 24th. Waste Management will only pass by once and please remember not to cover the sidewalk or water meter with your items.

Watering Trees in a DROUGHT



Don't forget to water your trees during drought conditions. Tree root systems, unlike carrots, typically don't dive downward but instead go outward spreading two to three times wider than the height of the tree and most absorbing roots are in the top foot of soil. Slowly apply water to soak (not drench) the entire area underneath the full span of a tree's canopy/branches. A damp soil that dries for a short period will allow adequate oxygen to permeate the soil. Trees that do not receive water from sprinkler systems or irrigation require additional water.

Applying mulch to trees also helps retain moisture. Just be sure not to have the mulch right next to the base of the tree. Water small and newly planted trees even more frequently, as they have less extensive root systems. You can check soil moisture by using a garden trowel and inserting it into the ground to a depth of 2", and then move the blade of the trowel back and forth to create a small narrow trench. Then use your finger to touch the soil. If it is moist to the touch, then they do not need water. A dry, yellow yard means the roots of any trees present are also dry.



We are fortunate this year to have an abundance of rainfall; however, our area is prone to flash flooding. The State of Texas leads the nation in flood-related fatalities. The first step in preventing flood-related fatalities and the damages caused by flooding is knowing your flood risk.

In 2004, Live Oak joined The Bexar Regional Watershed Management (BRWM) partners — Bexar County, the City of San Antonio, the San Antonio River Authority and 20 suburban cities in Bexar County. As funding partners, we undertook a comprehensive effort to update the County's flood risk maps which resulted in a more accurate depiction of the flood risk in Bexar County. In addition to converting the maps to a digital format, the BRWM updated flood studies and re-mapped many areas of the floodplain that had not been mapped since the 1970's.

In March 2010, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved the new Digital Flood Insurance Rate Maps for Bexar County. That means the floodplain maps for your area might have changed based on these more up-to-date flood studies.

Live Oak has since updated the city's existing flood ordinance. If you haven't done so, please log on to www.bexarfloodfacts.org and check the new flood maps to determine how the changes may impact our city and your property. If your property is near a drainage ditch or stream, please help do your part by keeping the area free of brush and debris. If you have any questions about the floodplain on your property, please call City Manager, Scott Wayman, at 210-653-9140, ext. 2261. We will come out to your property and help answer any flood related concerns or questions you may have.




