



Coordinator. We are always happy to answer questions about our programs and facilities, and love knowing that our community is enjoying these amazing amenities that Live Oak has to offer.


We look forward to a very busy and exciting 2019, and hope that you will join us for the ride!

Announcements from Public Works

Christmas Tree-cycle & Drop-off site

Each year, Live Oak offers a Christmas tree-cycle and drop off site across from the Live Oak Clubhouse at 7901 Shin Oak Drive until Friday, January 24, 2019. The mountain of trees that accumulate during the month of January will eventually be placed into the city's wood chipper and re-purposed into mulch, free to the public. Please remember to remove all tinsel, decorations and metal stands before you drop off your tree. Northeast Methodist Hospital Continues to Grow

Methodist Healthcare System will continue its expansion of the emergency department with the construction of a modern inpatient tower in 2019, a move that comes after a recent rise in demand to accommodate the growing population of the northeast region. Last year alone, the hospital treated more than 56,000 patients in its emergency department. The \$46 million major expansion project will include the construction of two new floors over the existing inpatient tower. This expansion is a crucial part of the overall master plan for the hospital and for the City and region. Along with the construction of additional operating rooms, the tower will have 60 additional patient beds. Construction crews and cranes will begin working at the site this month.

In November, the completion of the ER expansion added 17 additional patient beds designed to allow for increased patient privacy. By expanding the ER by approximately 9,000 square feet, Northeast Methodist Hospital is much larger with efficient space to offer service lines such as women's and children's health, orthopedics and cardiovascular services. On November 2nd a ribbon-cutting ceremony was held at the hospital to signal the completion of the ER expansion project. Mayor Mary M. Dennis, elected officials, city staff, Northeast Methodist Hospital CEO Michael Beaver, hospital staff and Tri-County Chamber of Commerce joined a crowd of nearly 200 to help cut the ribbon at the official dedication and Grand Opening of the new ER. "This is the beginning of an incredible new era. Northeast Methodist Hospital is not only delivering the best medical care, they are transforming the way a hospital functions and operates" said Mayor Mary Dennis. Everyone in attendance at the Grand Opening ceremony were provided with complimentary tours of the facility and entertained with food, drink and music.

Since opening its doors to the Live Oak community in 1995, the Northeast Methodist Hospital has adorned the corner of Judson Road and Toepperwein Road and has since been an instrumental part of the community. Northeast Methodist Hospital has seen several expansion projects throughout the years and have plans for many more in the future for the 14 acres adjacent to the hospital. We look forward to the hospital's continued success and to the future growth of their facilities and services offered to the northeast region.

Home Fires –

"Your car keys and the clothes on your back."

"That could be all you have left, if you are a survivor of a home fire."

Each year more than 2,500 people die and 12,600 are injured in home fires in the United States, with direct property loss due to home fires estimated at \$7.3 billion annually. Home fires can be prevented!

To protect yourself, it is important to understand the basic characteristics of fire. Fire spreads quickly; there is no time to gather valuables or make a phone call. In just two minutes, a fire can become life-threatening. In five minutes, a residence can be engulfed in flames.

Heat and smoke from fire can be more dangerous than the flames. Inhaling the super-hot air can sear your lungs. Fire produces poisonous gases that make you disoriented and drowsy. Instead of being awakened by a fire, you may fall into a deeper sleep. Asphyxiation is the leading cause of fire deaths, exceeding burns by a three-to-one ratio.

Get out Safely! Create and Practice a Fire Escape Plan

In the event of a fire, remember that every second counts, so you and your family must always be prepared. Escape plans help you get out of your home quickly.

Twice each year, practice your home fire escape plan. Some tips to consider when preparing this plan include:

Find two ways to get out of each room.

If the primary way is blocked by fire or smoke, you will need a second way out. A secondary route might be a window onto a neighboring roof or a collapsible ladder for escape from upper story windows.

Only purchase collapsible ladders evaluated by a nationally recognized laboratory, such as Underwriters Laboratory (UL).


Make sure that windows are not stuck, screens can be taken out quickly, and that security bars can be properly opened.

Practice feeling your way out of the house in the dark or with your eyes closed.

Windows and doors with security bars must have quick release devices to allow them to be opened immediately in an emergency.

Make sure everyone in the family understands and practices how to properly operate and open locked or barred doors and windows.

Teach children not to hide from firefighters.

vigilant against **SCAMMERS**

Protect yourself and your family from scammers and con artists. We have recently seen a different kind of criminal operation in the area. This type of operation is not new. It seems to come and go as groups of criminals move across the country.

In this scam, an individual or a small group will knock on your door. They explain that they are working in the area as contractors for a utility company, tree trimmers, surveyors, or utility line locators. They will come up with different stories to get you to take them into your back yard.

They will explain that since you live on the property you can assist them in finding an easement or survey marker. Or explain to you that a utility company has contracted them to cut tree limbs away from power or phone lines. They want you in the backyard to make sure they don't cut any limbs or bushes without your approval. They hope for two things. They hope you leave your front door unlocked and they hope to stall you as long as possible in the back yard. Once the crime is set in motion, other crew members will enter your home through the front door and burglarize your home in a matter of minutes. They will take cash, jewelry, electronics, anything they can grab and leave with in a hurry that looks valuable. The work crew tells you they are going to get tools from their truck and before you know it the thieves and your property are gone.



There are many ways you can protect yourself from this type of criminal activity.

Check the story. Are they wearing anything such as ID cards that identify them as utility workers or utility contractors? Are there markings on their vehicle indicating who they work for? Call the company and ask if they have any scheduled work crews in the area. If they are legitimate, they won't mind waiting. Never let these people in your house. This only gives them a better opportunity to look around and see what you have. They will usually communicate with each other by stepping away from you to make a phone call. They are calling their partners to let them know it is clear to go into the house. Also, don't leave large amounts of cash in your home. Don't leave jewelry and other valuables out in the open. If you have a safe, store your valuables and cash in it. At the very least keep things out of sight. If something doesn't feel right to you, believe me its probably not. Deny them access to your yard and home, no matter how pushy they get. Close the door, get a good description of the people and vehicles and call the police immediately.

Remember, keeping our community safe is a team effort between citizens and police. Working together we can stop this type of criminal activity. The goal of the police department is to keep Live Oak a safe place to live, work and play.

Backflow Testing and Winterization

By Somerville Backflow

The Texas winter months can be harsh and can effect exposed pipes including you above ground backflow device. This article is to provide residents with knowledge of backflow testing and proper winterization, which will save homeowners a lot of money and headache in replacing the device, when it cracks in cold weather.

Every year, the State of Texas, requires that the backflow device be tested for proper operation. For homeowners, that device is installed on your lawn irrigation system. Within the City of Live Oak, those devices are 99% of the time above ground and near the house. The backflow is there to provide protection to the water system in the event of a loss of water pressure due to main breaks, maintenance, etc. In those situations, if the backflow is performing as designed, there will be no contamination of the water supply in your area from your irrigation system. On an irrigation system, as every zone shuts off, water can pool near the heads of that particular zone. That water can then drain back into the piping thru the head itself. For those who fertilize or treat their yards with pesticides, that ultimately means there's a chance for some of those chemicals to find their way into the piping thru that scenario. If a homeowner's backflow does not work as intended, and there is a loss of pressure, that contaminated water will then be siphoned back to where the water was shut off for repairs or maintenance. Once repairs have been made, and the pressure restored, that contaminated water now travels back up the line, and is distributed to those affected by the main repair.

Now, onto winterizing the above ground backflow device. Properly preparing the device for winter is extremely easy and a cost saving effort on the part of the homeowner. Replacing these devices after a hard freeze can be costly not only in the replacement of the device itself, but also in the loss of water due to a breakage, thereby reflecting on your water bill. Two of the most common ways homeowners do this, is by wrapping the device in a mass of towels or other household materials, or by placing a decorative plastic rock over the top of it. Both of these work well, however most of the wrappings are done in such a way as to cause potential problems with the device itself. The other way to winterize is the most effective way, which is basically to





drain the water from the device, thereby drastically reducing the chance the device itself will crack from freezing. We provide the latter service to our customers, if they choose, but we also made 2 videos on our website showing how to do it yourself.




