## City Says Goodbye To Longtime Commissioner

The City of Live Oak and the Planning & Zoning Commission mourns the loss of one of their own. Longtime resident and Planning Commissioner, Harvey Johnson passed away unexpectedly on March 18, 2020. In November of 1999, Johnson was appointed by city council to the commission and served the majority of the 21 years as the commission's chairman or vice chairman.

On March 10th, before his death, Mayor Mary M. Dennis and the Live Oak City Council recognized Johnson amongst other members of the 2040 Comprehensive Plan Advisory Committee for their diligent work on the document for the City. During the recognition his daughter Jennifer, and two grandchildren, Grant and Abigail were in attendance to see him receive his plaque and certificate. With his tenure on the commission, he was instrumental in creating the new Comprehensive Plan along with countless Subdivision & Zoning Code amendments over the years. These important documents and zoning regulations are just a fraction of Johnson's service and accomplishments with the City of Live Oak.

Longtime friend and fellow commissioner Bill Umphlett said "he was a wonderful friend to me and was devoted to his family and to the commission. He will be greatly missed and I will never forget our time together serving on the commission. Johnson's selfless dedication and service to this community will never be forgotten by all who knew him."

Before his death, Johnson announced that he planned to "hang-up" his commissioner's hat in December 2020 to spend quality time with his family. Newly elected Chairman Rebecca Kochan said "it was a pleasure and an honor to be on the Planning Commission with Harvey and I appreciated all his wisdom and advice he gave me throughout the years. I will miss him."

The City of Live Oak will forever be indebted to his wisdom and integrity he brought to the commission. His life will be defined by a long career of teaching, serving his community, his gentleness and for the love he expressed for his family and friends. We will miss the soft spoken man we call "Chairman" and can only hope we make him proud with our future endeavors. Mr. Johnson was preceded in death by his wife Carol and son, Brian.





## **COVID-19 Pandemic Criminals**

The criminal element is always looking for an opportunity for cash. There are no rules, no boundaries and nothing is off limits. Now amid the COVID-19 pandemic criminals have new opportunities to prey on victims. People are being bombarded through telemarketing and social media with seemingly legitimate opportunities for everything from investments, PPE equipment, virus prevention and cures and anything else a scammer can think of to come between you and your money. As always, if it sounds too good to be true, it more than likely is.

There are scams for miracle cures and vaccines. There is no vaccine currently available that will prevent or cure COVID–19. If there were, you would not be hearing about it from someone calling you randomly on the telephone. The only protection and prevention we have are proper hygiene and distancing yourself from others.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) has been in short supply for months. When you purchase these items, make sure it is from a legitimate source. Unsolicited offers for these products are most likely bogus. Purchasing these items online from an unsolicited source will relieve you of your money and the possibility of no product. If you do receive a product there is no telling if it is safe. Health insurance scams are now everywhere. Phone calls and emails requesting your health insurance, personal and financial information are bogus. No legitimate business will contact you requesting this information so they may



schedule for COVID–19 testing. Government agencies will not contact you demanding that you must pay a fine or face arrest because you did not take a COVID–19 test.

Other scams are now disguised as charitable contributions or investment opportunities. If you wish to donate to a charitable organization, make sure it is one you know and trust. If not, at least do some research before sending money. Beware of unsolicited investment opportunities. Promises of fast return on your cash for new groundbreaking ventures, or when you hear the words "you must act now" should be a warning sign. Do not act immediately, better yet do not act at all, just hang up the phone.

Remember, scammers have no conscience. They do not care who you are, what difficulties you have, or hardships you are enduring. They want money and they do not care how they get it. Think smart, be thorough and report any suspicious or fraudulent activity to your police department.



## **SAFETY TIPS**

- Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- >>> The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Weep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill area.
- Weep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill.
- ))) Never leave your grill unattended.
- Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before lighting it.

## CHARCOAL GRILLS

- There are several ways to get the charcoal ready to use. Charcoal chimney starters allow you to start the charcoal using newspaper as a fuel.
- If you use a starter fluid, use only charcoal starter fluid. Never add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquids to the fire.
- Keep charcoal fluid out of the reach of children and away from heat sources.
- There are also electric charcoal starters, which do not use fire. Be sure to use an extension cord for outdoor use.
- When you are finished grilling, let the coals completely cool before disposing in a metal container.

## PROPANE Grills

Check the gas tank hose for leaks before using it for the first time each year. Apply a light soap and water solution to the hose. A propane leak will release bubbles. If your grill has a gas leak, by smell or the soapy bubble test, and there is no flame, turn off both the gas tank and the grill. If the leak stops, get the grill serviced by a professional before using it again. If the leak does not stop, call the fire department. If you smell gas while cooking, immediately get away from the grill and call the fire department. Do not move the grill.

If the flame **goes out**, turn the grill and gas off and wait at least **5 minutes** before re-lighting it.

## **FACTS**

- July is the peak month for grill fires.
- Roughly half of the injuries involving grills are thermal burns.

## **Fireworks Safety**

As the July 4th celebrations begin we wanted to remind you that you cannot set fireworks off in the city limits. Not only are they illegal but very dangerous. The city will continue to enforce, in compliance with state law, fire and safety regulations within the city.


## CODE CORNER

The following items are not allowed to be stored outside:

- Building materials (except where an "open building permit" has been issued)
- Garden Tools/Lawn Mowers
- Firewood
- Newspapers
- Indoor Furniture
- Coolers
- **Tires**
- **Appliances**
- Scrap Metal
- Any other discarded or worn out manufactured materials and machinery



Tip: Wanting to get rid of items in your house AND prevent outside storage? The City of Live Oak has a bulk pick-up twice a year. The spring date has already passed but the next date is coming up in the fall. Keep an eye out in the city magazine and the marquees across town for the next Bulk Pick-up date in fall!
