



Planning for our future

Dear Residents,

2019 was a year of great planning and progressive thinking for Live Oak! Our goals in 2019 were to create a city of the future in terms of policy and planning, mobility, and infrastructure. This in addition to providing extraordinary services to better serve the residents. So how did we plan for future challenges and growth? We made a considerable overhaul to the 2020 Comprehensive Plan and created an updated Comprehensive plan that will bring us into 2040. The process of updating the Comp Plan determined community goals and visions for future community development. Topics discussed dealt with public policies on transportation, utilities, land use, recreation, parks and housing. The final Comprehensive Plan 2040 will be approved this November.

An update to the master Parks Future Facility and Use Plan was accomplished as well in 2019. This plan would provide a 10-year vision for parks and its park facilities. The plan includes suggestions for updated parks equipment, trails, and an action plan prioritizing facility development and replacement. The planning process included a community-wide survey and public meetings to determine the needs for our park's future. One of the major projects estimated to be completed by the end of the year is for a park restroom facility to accommodate high capacity usage near the football fields.

We are very thankful for our successes and the growth of our city. With growth, as we all know by now, comes challenges, but more importantly, opportunities. Thanks to the citizen involvement throughout the year. Your involvement was key to the progressive thinking and actions for 2019. 
PET PAWLOOZA!





Did you know?

Thanksgiving is the leading day of the year for home fires involving cooking equipment.



Candle Safety

From 2007-2011 U.S. fire departments responded to an estimated 10,630 home structure fires that were started by candles. These fires caused 115 deaths, 903 injuries and \$418 million in direct property damage. Candles caused 4% of reported home fires, 5% of home fire deaths, 7% of home fire injuries, and 6% of direct property damage from home fires during this period.

Facts and figures

During the five-year period of 2007-2011:

Roughly one-third (36%) of home candle fires started in bedrooms.

On average, 29 home candle fires were reported per day.

Falling asleep was a factor in 11% of the home candle fires and 37% of the associated deaths.

More than half (56%) of home candle fires occurred when some form of combustible material was left or came too close to the candle.

Cooking is, by far, the leading cause of fires and fire-related injuries in residential buildings. Unattended cooking equipment is the leading factor contributing to the ignition of larger spreading cooking fires.

The highest incidence of cooking fires in residential buildings occurs on Thanksgiving Day, followed by Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

WATCH WHAT YOU HEAT!

Stay in the kitchen when you are frying, grilling or broiling food.

If you leave the kitchen for even a short period of time, turn off the stove.

If you are simmering, baking, roasting or boiling food, check it regularly and use a timer to remind you that you're cooking.

Have activities that keep kids out of the kitchen during busy time. Games, puzzles or books can keep them busy. Kids can get involved in Thanksgiving recipes that can be done outside the kitchen.

Northeast Methodist Hospital Expansion Going Vertical

In response to the economic growth of Northeast Bexar, Guadalupe and Comal Counties, Northeast Methodist Hospital is expanding its service lines and capacity to better serve and meet the needs of the surrounding communities.

In 2018, Northeast Methodist Hospital completed the emergency room expansion project by adding 17 new treatment rooms which now totals to more than 40 rooms overall. The growth of the hospital continued in the spring with the inpatient bed expansion. The scope of work includes: vertically expanding the existing tower by two floors which offers 60 new inpatient beds, growing the current mechanical powerhouse on the west side along with a new fire control room and adding mechanical, electrical and plumbing support systems. Additionally, there will be a new helipad on the rooftop that will allow for a seamless transition of care for patients from outlying areas. A new traction elevator will serve as patient transport from the rooftop vestibule to the emergency department and main patient floors.

The goal of this project is to increase the number of private patient rooms to better accommodate the community's growing needs. This 54,600 square foot expansion will add 30 new private rooms per floor and will increase the hospital's capacity to care for Intensive Care, Intermediate Care and Medical/Surgical patients.

Building on the hospital's track record of nearly 35 years of successes and service to our community, we look forward to supporting Northeast Methodist Hospital when it comes to providing the best healthcare to the entire northeast region.



Great Hearts Academy

Construction for Great Hearts Academy is going strong at the Gateway Shopping Center located off of Loop 1604. Phase I will include constructing a 56,600 square foot public charter school which is expected to house K-8 and the second phase will house grades 9-12 with 37,200 additional square feet as well as a gymnasium. Construction on the two-story buildings is being handled by general contractor Kencon Constructors/Construction Managers, Ltd. and was designed by HKS Inc. Crews from Ranger Excavating have been working diligently and smoothly for months as they complete the site work and lay the infrastructure for both Phase I and Phase II. Representatives estimate Phase I of the new charter school to be completed in July of 2020 and Phase II in July of 2022. Once both phases are completed, the charter school will accommodate 1400 students. Keep watching our Facebook page for updates and grand opening dates.



Live Oak Town Center Restaurant Pad Sites

Since the grand opening of IKEA in March, the Live Oak Town Center's management team, the Weitzman Group and EDC staff have been feverishly working to attract a diverse selection of restaurants and retailers. The Weitzman Group has the experience and strong relationships with retailers to ensure they are meeting the needs of our community while accommodating the needs of the potential tenants interested in the Town Center. Most recently, they have acquired developers from four restaurant chains requesting lots that will be situated along the prime frontage of the Town Center and access road of IH 35 and Pat Booker. Dirt has been moving since August in preparation of the four restaurant sites. We are proud to announce that construction has begun on Olive Garden on one of the four sites. No tentative date has been set for the completion of the Live Oak Olive Garden but we will certainly keep you updated with information on all incoming businesses in the Hometown News magazine and our Facebook page.

Vista Ridge Subdivision Phase I Is Complete

Tips for Calling 9-1-1

IS A PERSON HURT OR SICK? If a person is injured, sick, not breathing or unable to respond. Call 911 and give the 911 Dispatcher your location, nature of illness or injury, phone number you are calling from, and any other details that are pertinent.

IS THERE A FIRE? If you see smoke or flames call 911, give the 911 Dispatcher the location, what is on fire, if anyone is inside of building or vehicle? Do not break windows unless you know the person is on the other side of that window. Breaking windows adds oxygen to the fire, which can make the fire grow larger and more dangerous.

WITNESS A CRIME OR ACCIDENT? Is someone's health or safety in danger, call 911 give location, events that are occurring, and a description of the assailant, victim, and vehicle information if available?

IF YOU DO CALL 9-1-1, EVEN BY MISTAKE, DO NOT HANG UP THE PHONE. If you happen to call by accident, stay on the line until you can tell the call taker that you called by accident and there is no emergency. This saves the call taker from having to call you back and confirm there is no emergency or possibly sending police with lights and sirens to check your address for an emergency.

WHEN CALLING 9-1-1 DO YOUR BEST TO STAY CALM AND ANSWER ALL QUESTIONS. Staying calm can be one of the most difficult, yet most important. It is the questions 9-1-1 call takers ask, no matter how relevant they seem, are important in helping get the first responders to you as fast as possible.

HELP THE 9-1-1 CALL TAKER HELP YOU. Listen and answer the questions asked. By doing this, it helps the call taker understand your situation and will assist you with your emergency until the appropriate police, fire or medical units arrive.


KNOW THE LOCATION OF THE EMERGENCY. The wireless 9-1-1 caller must be aware that the 9-1-1 center that answers the call may not be the 9-1-1 center that services the area that the wireless caller is calling from. Look for landmarks, cross street signs and buildings.

TEACH YOUR CHILDREN HOW TO CALL 9-1-1. Be sure they know what 9-1-1 is, how to dial from your home and cell phone. When calling 9-1-1 your child needs to know their name, parent's name, telephone number, and most importantly their address. Tell them to answer all the call takers questions and to stay on the phone until instructed to hang up.

PRANK CALLS TO 9-1-1 WASTE TIME AND ARE ILLEGAL
Be sure all members of your household are aware that prank or harassing calls to 9-1-1 will be dealt with by local law enforcement agencies. In Texas a person can be arrested for abusing 911 or interfering and preventing another person who is trying to call 911 for help.

TEXT 911 is a good option if you are hearing impaired or will compromise your safety, if you speak out loud. This may include domestic violence, home invasions, abductions, and school shootings. Provide the location, name, details of what is happening, call back number.





COMMUNITY NEEDS TO KNOW

Connect CTY Telephone Alert System

In the event of an emergency the Connect CTY Telephone Alerting System will be the primary means of notifying our citizens. The Live Oak Communications Center (dispatch) has direct access and can prepare and send a message within minutes. As such we encourage all citizens to keep their telephone numbers up-to-date in the system. This includes your land line – if you still have one, along with your cellular numbers for telephone calls and text messages. You can also include an e-mail address if you desire. In

addition to emergency messages, the City may use the system to pass along important information like street closures or water outages. On occasion we may send out a call regarding City events in the park or parades. As a reminder too, there are NO individual costs for this service and the data base is secure.

In order to update your telephone numbers or to remove them from the Connect CTY data base, citizens may simply go to the City Web Site. Under “Residents” select the Connect CTY item and follow the instructions. A word of caution however! As noted earlier, this telephone system is our primary means of communicating with our citizens in an emergency. One last item! If you are planning to move out of the City and keep your same home phone numbers you will continue to receive calls unless you delete your name/numbers. Know Your Flood Risk

We have been unfortunate this year with not having an abundance of rainfall but when rain does fall, our area is prone to flash flooding. The State of Texas leads the nation in flood-related fatalities. The first step in preventing flood-related fatalities and the damages caused by flooding is knowing your flood risk.

In 2004, Live Oak joined The Bexar Regional Watershed Management (BRWM) partners — Bexar County, the City of San Antonio, the San Antonio River Authority and 20 suburban cities in Bexar County. As funding partners, we undertook a comprehensive effort to update the County’s flood risk maps which resulted in a more accurate depiction of the flood risk in Bexar County. In addition to converting the maps to a digital format, the BRWM updated flood studies and re-mapped many areas of the floodplain that had not been mapped since the 1970’s.



In March 2010, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved the new Digital Flood Insurance Rate Maps for Bexar County. That means the floodplain maps for your area might have changed based on these more up-to-date flood studies. Live Oak has since updated the city’s existing flood ordinance. If you haven’t done so, please log on to www.bexarfloodfacts.org and check the new flood maps to determine how the changes may impact our city and your property. If your property is near a drainage ditch or stream, please help do your part by keeping the area free of brush and debris. If you have any questions about the floodplain on your property, please call City Manager, Scott Wayman, at 210-653-9140, ext. 2261. We will come out to your property and help answer any flood related concerns or questions you may have.


THREE TYPES OF STORMWATER POLLUTION

All types end up discharging into waterways as sediment, sludge and solids. These can be caught in expensive stormwater treatment filters, but the most effective way to reduce this problem is to prevent pollution from entering the stormwater system in the first place.






