



Live Oak First Baptist Church Celebrates 40th "Continuing the Good Work"





Live Oak Baptist Church began as a humble vision by a group of Christians in 1974. The group began meeting at Live Oak Elementary, now known as Ed Franz Elementary, as a church home until land could be purchased for a new church. That same year, the Old Mill located at 109 Gibbs Sprawl in Converse would be obtained for a temporary meeting site. The Old Mill building was cleaned, renovated and furnished with an old pulpit from Palm Heights Baptist Church and odd collections of furniture provided

by members. Schertz Baptist Church would get involved by loaning them folding chairs to help with seating during the services. During their first week, the church would require a bank account to conduct daily and weekly business transactions. In opening the bank account, the church would require a name. At that moment the members decided to name the church, Toepperwein Baptist Mission.

The perfect land was purchased on Toepperwein Road in 1975 under Pastor Gilbert Kendrick's leadership and the ground breaking ceremony was celebrated on February 8, 1976. The land acquired was located at 11560 Toepperwein Road where the church stands proudly today. Construction at the new site would begin in the spring of 1976. Church members worked





tirelessly throughout the evenings and weekends to keep the construction and labor cost to a minimum. After two years





into their vision, the "worship center" was completed and the first service was held on August 8, 1976. The San Antonio Baptist Association and the pastor at that time made the vision a reality by having it constituted and dedicated on September 10, 1978. The name was then officially changed to Live Oak First Baptist

Church. Over the years, membership continued to grow and additional buildings would be necessary. Between 1980 and 1993, the church has continued to add new buildings such as the Education building and the Fellowship Hall, and enlarged the Sanctuary. Upon completion of the new and renovated buildings, the church would be completely debt free.

Throughout their history, Live Oak First Baptist Church has continued to support and empower their followers by cosponsoring the establishment of Woodlake Baptist Church, Judson Road Baptist Mission, and Cibolo Valley Baptist Church. The Church has also sponsored Grupo Gratitudad (Spanish AA) for the past twenty years along with the Boy Scout and Cub Scout Troops #239 since 2014. On Sunday, September 16th, Pastor Donald Valenta and members of Live Oak First Baptist Church commemorated their "good work" started over 40 years ago with a huge anniversary celebration. The church grounds were filled with music, fun activities, food, guest speakers, and special guests from the San Antonio Baptist Association and the Baptist General Convention of Texas. A proclamation was presented to Pastor Valenta by Live Oak's Mayor Pro-Tem Ed Cimics and Councilman Bob Tullgren during the celebration. The vear ahead will be a year of joy, enthusiasm, growth, and

achievement for the missionminded church and its members. We congratulate them for their impressive history, pure nostalgia and their committed congregation making a difference in Live Oak every day.



Rolling out THE IGNITOR

The Live Oak Fire Department is proud to introduce the newest Fire Apparatus to the citizens of Live Oak. Our 2018 "Ferrara Ignitor" is a state of the art custom rescue pumper. This truck carries 750 gallons of water and 30 gallons of "Class-A" foam and can pump at the rate of 1500 gallons per minute. Adding the capability of firefighting foam to the department, it is sure to help our firefighters mitigate any firefighting incident thrown at them. This rescue pumper carries medical Advanced Life Support equipment and serves as a backup medical engine for our citizens. Its versatility doesn't stop there though as it will respond to accidents to help firefighters perform vehicle stabilization and patient extrication utilizing a variety of rescue tools and equipment. It is also equipped for high and low angle rescues, structural collapse rescue, trench rescue, swiftwater rescues and Hazardous Material incidents. New required safety features include a roll cage, air bags, roll over protection plus side and rear cameras. The build of this apparatus has been in the making for over a year by a committee of firefighters assembled under former Fire Chief Charles Foster. This truck was built by the Ferrara fire truck company in Louisiana, as they came in with the lowest price, a reputation of guality construction and durability, and a local service center to handle any future repairs or warranty issues.



Mayor Mary Dennis made a special trip to the fire station to view the pumper the week it was delivered. With the



assistance of crew members from C-Shift, she was one of the first people to sit in the driver's seat and admire its grandeur. "I'm confident that Chief Surber and the Live Oak Firefighters have selected the most adequate apparatus to serve our citizens and the region during a time of need," said Mayor Dennis. Winter Sewer Averaging & Why?

Have you ever found yourself sitting around a table of friends and the topic of "Winter Sewer Averaging" pops up for discussion? Probably not, but it does have a significant impact on your water/sewer bill. Well, let's get you informed.

What Is Winter Sewer Averaging?

Winter sewer averaging is the process by which the city determines the amount of wastewater your home generates during the winter months

t.

for the basis for your wastewater charges. The City billing system calculates the average volume of water that you use during the winter months and then utilizes this three month average as the basis in determining your wastewater bill for a 12 month period.

The City of Live Oak Utility utilizes the months of December, January and February to determine this amount. This averaging process is a standard practice and produces a fair and accurate consumption during the months when most of the water that is used is conveyed to our sewer system. Typically there is less lawn and tree watering, pool filling, recreational water use and car washing during those months so it is logical to think that the water that issued during those month go into the sewer. This three month average then becomes the basis for your sewer charge on your utility bill during the year beginning on October 1. The next winter the monitoring starts over.

Does Conserving Water In The Winter Actually Save Us Money All Year Long?

This is a definite "yes". Using less water during the sewer averaging period will result in a corresponding lower wastewater bill throughout the entire year. Here are ways to reduce your winter time water use and consequently your monthly wastewater bill:

1. Conserve water in traditional ways –

*Low flow toilets, turn water off when not in use. Limit shower time. You can find many ways to conserve water online at **SAWS.

2. Fix all leaky fixtures –

This one is a mundane tip but leaks are a major culprit of unintentional water use in our homes.

3. Don't wash your car at home -

Many car wash facilities use re-use water.

4. Turn off your irrigation system -

Your landscaping probably won't need or will need less water during the winter months since the plants will be dormant.

Gold Zone - Collection of the Gold Zone begins the first Thursday of every month. Area begins at Judson Road and IH 35 and includes Retama Hollow, Brentwood Oaks, Bridlewood and Lookout Road. Also includes original Live Oak North of Leafy Hollow.

Green Zone - Collection of the Green Zone begins the third Thursday of every month. Area includes all of Woodcrest and original Live Oak South of and including Leafy Hollow.



Waste Management will pass through each street only once, all brush must be placed curbside prior to the first day of scheduled pickup. The tree and shrub trimmings must be less than or equal to 12 inches (12") in diameter and the pile may not exceed 12 feet (12') in length, 5 feet (5') in height and 5 feet (5') in width.

In addition to monthly brush pickup, Waste Management will collect brush that is cut and bundled on your second regular trash day of the week. Bundles may not exceed 4 feet (4') in length and 35 pounds in weight per bundle. As a reminder, Waste Management is not responsible for the collections of work completed by contractors. 
